




Men's League teams playing on the morning of Wednesday August 20. It had rained heavily overnight and the carpet was wet but still quite suitable for bowling.

New Door

The Town is planning to proceed with the installation of a door into the Locker Room from the hall at the end of the season thereby eliminating the need to have access to the Mori Room in order to enter the Locker Room. The proposal to do this first appeared in a 2017 Planning Report, so it only took them 8 years to get around to it.

The Town now has a new draft Parks and Recreation Master Plan. At present they are collecting feedback from registered users. One possibility that is mentioned is adding a gymnasium to the Community Centre and enclosing the lawn bowling green.
